- not reveal personal addresses or contact numbers over the internet including my own
- not knowingly introduce a virus
- fully charge my device each evening in preparation for the next school day
- regularly backup school files on my device to Google Drive/external hard drive
- be supervised by my Parents/Caregivers who will monitor my use of the device and internet at home as this is not the responsibility of the school
- promptly report to staff any inappropriate material that is accidentally accessed at school
- promptly report damage to the hardware and/or software to the IT Support staff
- transport my device in a protective bag at all times.
- keep my device clean and free of graffiti and stickers
- take all reasonable precautions to ensure that the device is not lost or damaged
- store device safely not on the floor
